

Understanding the Core Values of Dharma

Acharya Darshanand

Dharma is a Sanskrit word that comes from the verbal root Dhri-to sustain. Dharma is that which sustains an individual, a society, and a country. What sustains? Everything has inherent qualities or properties that shape the unique identity of that thing. For example, fire gives heat and energy. These are the core qualities of fire. Some core qualities of water are its coolness and purifying nature. Likewise, human beings have core qualities or values that allow us to be humans. When we deviate from these qualities, we do not live up to our potential as humans. Our Rishis and Munis have given us a set of core values or qualities, which allow us to develop human potential to its optimum. Dharma embodies core human values. Dharma as "Vastu Swabhaavo Dharmah" implies that there are core values that sustain a being or an object. Maharshi Manu characterized Dharma with ten core values. Below is a brief description of each.

Dhriti is the first one and it means perseverance or steadfast. This quality is important for success in any endeavor. The second one is Kshamaa, which means tolerance. In life, we have to learn to tolerate others even when their behaviors may not be proper. Sometimes, we also commit mistakes and other people tolerate us. It is important to learn from one's mistakes and take the necessary steps to prevent them in future. Committing the same mistakes again and again would indicate that learning is not occurring; as a result, the tolerance of others may be exhausted.

The third aspect of Dharma is *Damah*. Damah means regulating one's mental thoughts. Sometimes, people are worried, anxious, and have negative thoughts. It is important to be aware of these thoughts and find the causes. For example, a student may be anxious of passing an exam. A little anxiety may be fine, but if it prevents learning, then strategies should be taken to reduce it. The fourth aspect is *Asteyam*, which means non-stealing. Not taking what is not yours should be observed in thought, word, and deed. Be satisfied with what you have, and strive to achieve what you want.

Shaucham is the fifth core value of Dharma and it means cleanliness of body and mind. A clean body and mind allows people to accomplish their goals and objectives in life. The sixth aspect of Dharma is *Indriyanigraha*. It means regulating the senses, and engaging in behaviors that are conducive to the development of good character. Dhee is the seventh aspect of Dharma and it pertains to developing the intellect. In Gayatri Mantra, the last part of the mantra is "Dhiyo yo nah prachodayaat" – May the Divine being inspire and guide our intellect, thoughts so that we may trod on the path of enlightenment.

The eighth component of Dharma is *Vidya*, which refers to learning, or acquiring knowledge. A Sanskrit poet highlights the value of learning "Eating, sleeping, and raising a family are common characteristics among humans and other species. Acquiring knowledge of this world, one's self, and how to live a meaningful life is what differentiates us from the lower species. Without this knowledge, humans are similar to animals." The ninth attribute of Dharma is *Satyam*. Satyam means truthfulness or honesty in thought, word, and deed. Finally, the tenth component of Dharma is *Akrodha*, which means absence of anger. Anger is an emotion that emanates from the mind. If anger is not recognized at the mental level, it may flow in speech, and body language in subtle ways and sometimes in harmful ways.

In conclusion, these core values of Dharma are interconnected. When people practice dhriti (steadfastness), they develop the ability to regulate their mind (damah), and may also avoid the negative emotion of anger (akrodha).
